## 2012 Summer League Season

Some of you have inquired of me regarding the schedule for the 2012 Summer League Season so that you can begin to make summer vacation plans and what-not.

At this time, I am scheduled to meet with the other members the SMSL League Board together as a group to discuss the details of the 2012 season on January 27th, we will create a meet schedule and a hard and fast Championship meet date. Once I return to the office on Monday January 31<sup>st</sup>, I will email you all the information I receive at that meeting.

After that I will begin preparations for the upcoming season and will keep you posted with information regarding suit try-on's, (due to popular demand we will be looking into an alternative style for the girls' suits this year) registration dates, fees and other details.

For now, I *can* give you a rough idea of the season dates in general:

As far as I can see **practices will begin Tuesday May 29<sup>th</sup>** (day after Labor Day), our **first meet** (intersquad meet, just our team) will be on **Saturday June 2<sup>nd</sup>** and **Championships will be on Saturday July 21st, 2012.**

We will have meets all but one Saturday beginning June 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Saturday we will NOT have a meet is TBD.

Late in last year's season the League Representatives took an informal vote and decided to dispense with the "Tri Meet" format and only hold dual meets for the entire season from now on. This means that there will be one team each year that we will not swim against and we will rotate every year which team we skip. But we will all have a chance to compete against all of the other teams in Championships.
