MEMORIAL/HERITAGE TREE & BENCH PROGRAM

Sponsored by Belton Parks and Recreation, the memorial/Heritage tree and Bench Program allows groups and individuals to donate trees and benches to commemorate special events or as memorials to loved ones. Trees and benches purchased through the program are planted and placed in city parks and along trails. Exact placement is at the discretion of the Parks and Recreation Department.



TREE PROGRAM

Cost of the program is \$350 per tree. This includes the tree, plaque and continued maintenance of the tree (fertilizing, pruning, mulching, etc.). After the tree is planted, the contact person will receive a certificate and map of the planting location.
