



General Water Park

- The pool management has the authority to implement and enforce rules that are more stringent or that supplement those listed based on the pool environment for your safety. Parents or guardians are responsible for supervising their children. Lifeguards are on duty to enforce rules and respond in cases of emergency.
- All children under age 3 must wear a SWIM diaper. SWIM diapers are available for purchase at the front desk. Diapers must be changed at the diaper changing stations in the changing rooms.
- Food and gum and are not allowed in the pool.
- No glass containers of any kind are allowed in the water park.
- Coolers and outside food and drinks may not be brought into the facility.
- Running is not allowed at any time.
- Children 10 years old and above are allowed admission to the water park without the supervision of a parent or guardian.
- Children 9 years of age and younger must be supervised by an adult or guardian 16 years of age or older and they must be in the same water park area as the child.
- Swimsuits are required. Cutoffs, thongs, basketball shorts, bras, tank tops or other swim attire determined inappropriate by management will not be permitted.
- All persons entering the water park, including supervising adults, must pay admission fees.
- Smoking, vaping, or use of tobacco products is not permitted within the facility.
- Patrons are not to visit with guards while on duty.
- Flotation devices, personal inner-tubes, and suits with built in flotation are not allowed.
- No alcohol permitted. People under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted.
- Anyone failing to obey rules or instructions, either verbal or written, may be ejected from the pool without refund of admission fee.
- Children under the age of 18 are not permitted to be in the pool during the adult swim. Children are required to stay behind the gutters with their feet and legs out of the water. Babies and infants under 2 years of age are permitted to be in the water in an adult's arms during this time.

Action River

- Please enter and exit the action river only at designated areas.
- Children are not allowed to play on the steps, hang or play on railings.
- Running, rough play, pushing or horseplay is not allowed.
- Dragging of tubes across deck is prohibited.
- Non-swimmers or children shorter than 48" must be accompanied by a parent or guardian 16 years of age or older.
- All tubes are FREE to use, but are available on a first come, first serve basis.
- Tubes must be returned to the storage bins while not being used and during pool safety breaks.

Slide

- Elderly persons, those suffering from heart disease, high blood pressure, or persons using prescription medication should consult their physician before using the water slide.
- Must be in a supine position on back when riding down the slides.
- Sunglasses, glasses, and goggles are prohibited on the slides.
- Double tubes are not allowed on slides.
- When going down slide again, ride river to Basketball exit, get out and carry tube to steps of slide.
- Guardians are not allowed to catch their children at the end of any slide.
- Patrons must be 42" to use the slides.
- No running up the slide steps.

Kid's Cove

- Parents must be within an arm's reach away from children who are non-swimmers.
- Flotation devices, water wings, personal inner tubes and suits with built in flotation are not allowed.
- No horseplay.
- Children over the age of 5 are not permitted to use the swings.

Basketball Area – Not available due to Covid 19 at this time

- No horseplay
- Touching rim, net and dunking are not allowed.
- Basketballs must stay in basketball area.
- Players must be in the water to participate.

Cargo Crossing

- No horseplay or hanging on other patrons.
- Once you fall off, go directly to the ladder, and get out.

Changing rooms

- No horseplay or loitering in changing rooms.
- No lingering in shower area.
- Food is not allowed in the changing rooms.
- Do not loiter or play near outdoor locker area.
- Belton Parks and Recreation and its staff are not responsible for loss of personal belongings.

Concessions

- All trash must be placed in recycling and trash receptacles provided.

Weather Policy

The outdoor pool will be closed for the following weather-related reasons:

Lightning & Thunder

If lightning is sighted or thunder is heard the outdoor pool will be closed immediately and will remain closed until 30 minutes after the last sighting of lightning or sound of thunder.

Temperature

For the outdoor pool to open for recreational swim the air temperature must be at least 70 degrees. If it is not 70 degrees by 12pm weather conditions will be re-evaluated at 1pm to open at 2pm. If the temperature is not 70 degrees by 1pm the outdoor pool will remain closed until 4pm. If at 4pm the air temperature is not 70 degrees, the outdoor pool will be closed for the day.

Rain

The outdoor pool can be open during rain but must be closed immediately if the lifeguards are unable to see the main drain at any time.

Tornado Warning

During a tornado warning all outdoor pool users will go the locker rooms and await instructions from supervisor.

COVID 19 GUIDELINES

Capacity Reduction – Due to Covid 19 the capacity for the outdoor waterpark has been reduced to 165

- Pool Pass does not guarantee entry to the facility when capacity is reached, no refunds given

Temperature Checks – Patrons will have their temperature checked at the admissions gate. Any patron with 100.4 or higher will be denied access into the facility. If you do not feel good or have Covid 19 symptoms, please stay home!

Deck Loungers – Deck loungers will NOT be available, but you may bring your own into the waterpark

Hourly Sanitary Cleaning Breaks – There will be a 15-minute break each hour so that staff can clean frequently touched surfaces
